TEAM BEACHER POLICIES.

Leadership is integral to lifelong learning. Student leadership is driven by service to others and is embedded in our school mission *“to provide quality university education and training and to embody the aspirations of the Kenyan people and the global community through creation, preservation, integration, transmission and utilization of knowledge.”*

In accordance with the University mission, we therefore take this opportunity to present to you our team policies.

1. Creation of needy student’s kitty.

As you all know education is the key to success and lack of fees we think should not be a barrier to some of us from reaching their success. As students who have gone through a lot of hardships in terms of school fees payment, we would like to inform our fellow comrades who are going through the same that team Beacher has a solution for this. In our capacity as your leaders we will create a student’s kitty that will help us pay for any student in need of fees his/her fees.

How are we going to do this?

- a) We will open an account with the school and the following will be the signatories;
 - I. Director of the campus.
 - II. Assistant dean of students.
 - III. Programme coordinators (to confirm that you are really in need of the money (fees).
 - IV. The sitting chairman of UNSA.

- b) Sit down with administration and bargain with them to channel money obtained from hiring of school facilities e.g. Auditorium to needy student's kitty.
- c) Solicit funds for these students from our local politicians, NGO's and any person of good will (in this case students are also invited) willing to support this programme.
- d) Hold harambee's in order to meet our financial target for these students.
- e) Money will be sent directly to the applicant's (student) portal.

2. Student's parking space.

We have observed the struggles some of us are going through when it comes to parking of cars. Some of you come late to class not because you are late but because you have been struggling to look for parking. Team Beacher is here for you and is much willing to solve this issue during our time in office once and for all. We are ready to bargain with the administration for an establishment of a suitable and more secure parking for University of Nairobi students so that you attend your classes in time without worrying on the safety of your vehicles.

3. Student's mess and center.

We want to advocate for a student's mess and center where students will be having their meals at a pocket friendly prices and also a place where they can be playing or watching football matches or news at their own convenient time. We will engage with the administration after the establishment of the student's mess to allow the mess to be manned by the students themselves and the revenue collected can be channeled to the needy student's kitty.

4. Inclusivity.

Team Beacher's government will be an all-inclusive government. Our office will be open to every students irrespective of your school or faculty to bring ideas and projects that are for the prosperity and betterment of our school.

5. Promotion of co-curricular activities.

As an all-inclusive government we are going to create an environment where every student's talent is much appreciated. And we invite any students talented in any game to register with the games captain so that we can be able to manage ourselves in terms of training sessions and management of school games facilities.

6. Student's internships and attachments.
